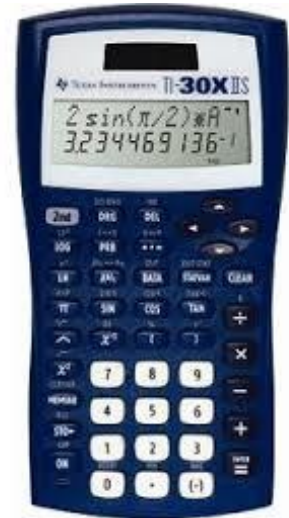


Calculator Policy

A non-graphing calculator with logarithmic and exponential capabilities is **required**. The **TI30 XIIS** (solar) or **TI30 XIIB** (battery) with a two-line display is preferred (pictured to the right).



Graphing calculators are **NOT** allowed on tests, on the Final Exam, or in the LSU Math Lab.

Calculators with symbolic notation or natural display capabilities, such as the TI-36XPro and any of the TI Multiview series, Casio Natural Display series or ClassWiz series, HP SmartCalc series, and Sharp Writeview series, are **NOT** allowed on tests, the Final Exam, or in the LSU Math Lab.

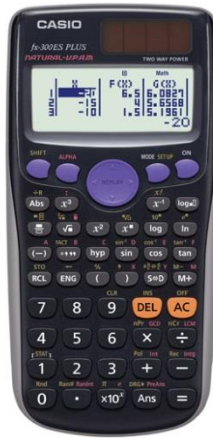
Following are some examples of calculators **NOT** allowed in the LSU Math Lab or in the Testing Center:

Casio uses the description **Natural Display**.

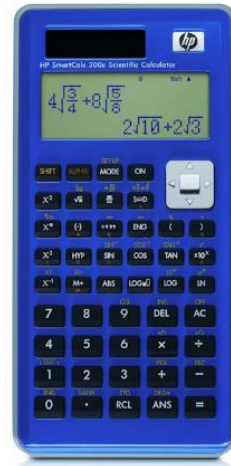
FX-115ES Plus



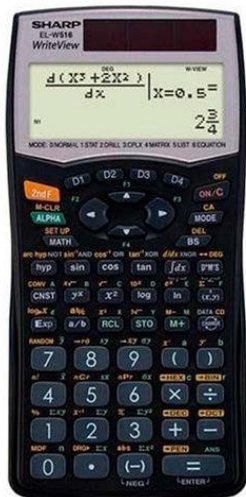
FX-300ES Plus
