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Put this at the very top:

```
\DocumentMetadata{ pdfstandard=ua-2, pdfstandard=a-4f, tagging=on,  
tagging-setup={math/setup={mathml-SE,mathml-AF}} }  
\documentclass[12pt]{article}  
\usepackage{ifluatex}\ifluatex\usepackage{unicode-math,fontspec}  
\else\usepackage[utf8]{inputenc}\usepackage[T1]{fontenc}\fi
```

For alt text:

- Images, figures, etc:
 - `\begin{figure}`
 - `\includegraphics{plot.pdf}`
 - `\alt{Line graph showing ...}`
 - `\caption{Example plot}`
 - `\end{figure}`
- Remember to use your standard section headers!
